The search for survivors in Japan continues, following Friday's tsunami. On the 18th March 2011 a tsunami struck, which devastated Japan. Over 18'000 people have been reported missing or dead.

The 500mph wave swept through Japan, destroying cars, sinking ships and levelling buildings. Most children were unharmed, due to schools being built on higher grounds, but thousands of adults were in city centres, working and shopping, which is where the wave had the most effect.

Families are restlessly searching for missing loved ones, which in some cases has proved futile, though in many cases, people have been found alive.
